## Hope Was Born That Night

"For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." – Isaiah 9:6

Dear

Isaiah 9:6 is a prophecy about a future child who would bear the government on his shoulders and be called titles that could only rightfully be attributed to God. At the time, the people of Judah felt powerless against their enemies. They didn't know if God was for them or against them, or if he had simply abandoned them.

This verse brings comfort, giving many names for the anticipated Messiah. Not only will Jesus bear the responsibility of governing the people ("authority rests on his shoulders"), but Verse 7 tells us he'll do it forever.

The titles used speak to Jesus' role as a living God.

- Wonderful Counselor—Jesus Christ is an advocate and gives guidance for life through His divine wisdom.
- Mighty God—A human couldn't save the people. Only God Himself was powerful enough to deliver us.
- Everlasting Father—The people of the time understood
